

Repairing The House Of The Lord!

II Chronicles 24:4

We want to share some exciting news with you! The Church Board and Building Committee have been working on issues that were brought up in the 2012 Business Meeting, and at the May 21, 2013 Church Business Meeting it was voted to move forward with repairing the house of the Lord. This is great news because this project will ensure that we have an evangelistic series in October, our parking lot will not deteriorate further, and our church body and staff will be safe and that our church structure will reflect that we care about the house of the Lord.

The issues presented at the May 2013 Business Meeting were:

1: Parking Lot Issues

- Extensive cracking
- Some areas of the asphalt is badly damaged
- One area the sub-base and asphalt is badly damaged
- Whole asphalt surface needs resealing
- We have been advised that if we don't do something soon to repair the asphalt our only option then will be to repave the whole parking lot at approximate cost of \$150,000.

2. Security Issues

- Transients using courtyard as bathroom
- Transients using breezeway to sleep day and night
- Multiple break-ins over the past few years with broken windows
- Skateboarders
- Sabbath School teachers have been harassed and peered at through the door windows multiple times while working in their Sabbath School rooms

3. Bathroom Issues

- Not handicapped accessible
- Bad odor
- · Cramped and crowed with not enough stalls
- Stalls too small
- Not representative of God's house

4. Electrical Panel

- Present 200 amp panel maxed out
- Will need to upgrade for future building projects
- · Will need if air conditioning is wanted

The Solutions Voted Upon at the May 2013 Business Meeting in the Order Of Priority!

- 1. Parking Lot
 - Fill all the cracks
 - · Replace some badly damaged asphalt
 - Reseal the entire parking lot surface
 - (Still investigating the cost of Sub-base repair)
- 2. Security Walls to enclose both ends of the breezeway
 - Walls, windows and doors to match existing structure
- 3. Bathrooms
 - Voted to build new bathrooms extending out the front of the church (see floor plan)
 - Turn existing bathrooms into an enlarged foyer with a window wall to face the courtyard
- 4. Upgrade the electrical panel to 400 amp service

In addition to the above, it was also voted to conduct an evangelistic campaign in October 2013 entitled Islam and Christianity by Pastor Tim Roosenberg. This will be a ten night series that is very relevant and appealing to the community given the current state of world affairs.

Following are the projected costs:


