Church Finances...

Finance Report from the Church Treasurer

Thank you for your continued support of the local Church budget. To review, our monthly budget goal is \$13,237/monthly. The offering for June 2013 was \$13,038 and the offering for July 2013 was \$10,350. We currently have a deficit of - \$4,875 for the first 10 months of our budget year. The total local budget offerings (10 months) show a

decrease of 2.9% compared to the same time last year. The total tithe shows a decrease of 2.5% compared to last year.

Stewardship is the personal acknowledgement on our part that God is owner and provider of all the needs of life - spiritual, physical, and material. As Christians, we are called to be faithful and responsible with the resources entrusted to us by God – our time, our talents, our assets, and

the use of our spiritual gifts.

Your strong support of the current building project has been a blessing. You can see the progress in the repair of the parking lot. Please mark September 29, 2013 on your calendar. This will be our annual Church Business meeting to review our current budget and vote on a new proposed budget for the year Oct 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014.

Repairing the House...Building Committee Report

"Repairing the House of the Lord" is in full swing. Many of you have noticed some changes. The most visible change is the Church parking lot. Multiple areas of defective asphalt have been removed and replaced with new asphalt. The concrete island, in the front of the church, has been removed. All of the cracks in the asphalt have been sealed. The whole parking lot has been seal coated with two coats of asphalt sealer. The parking lot stripes have been repainted. Thank you for your financial support! We now have years of service from our newly repaired parking lot. The electrical project should be done by the time you receive this newsletter. On Tuesday, September 3, the power company will be turning the power off to the church. They will be replacing the existing transformer and running new wires across Garden Valley Rd. This will connect to a new meter base on the outside of the church. This updating of the church's electrical system was very much needed and involved extensive trenching from the church to the power pole. (A short section of the sidewalk had to be removed for the trenching.) New electrical conduit was run in the attic and across the fover ceiling to connect the new meter base to the new electrical breaker boxes in the furnace room. All that remains of the electrical project is to repair some holes in the walls and ceiling, construct a soffit around the electrical conduit running across the ceiling of the foyer, and

pour concrete where the sidewalk was removed. With this additional wattage, we will be able to expand in the future. This would enable us to have air conditioning in the future if the church family so desires. Your generosity allowed us to act quickly when the power company changed its position and gave us permission to go over Garden Valley Blvd. instead of boring under the street which saved us over \$10.000.

Our plans for the security walls have been submitted to a local engineer for egress analysis. Once that is complete they will then be submitted to the local building department for their approval and the issuing of the necessary building permits. We hope to start building the security walls by the end of the month.

Before we can proceed with the bathroom remodel we still need to continue to raise the necessary funds. So far donations and pledges to "Repairing the House of the Lord" campaign are just a few dollars shy of \$89,000 dollars. We praise God for your faithful support of this project! Please prayerfully consider how you will continue to support this project. We not only need your financial support but also your physical support as we are trying to do as much of this project ourselves, as the budget we are working with assumes donated help. Prayerfully consider how YOU can help as we continue to "Repair the House of the Lord." -The Building Committee

Recipe... Asparagus & Red Pepper Fritatta by Chef Mark Anthony

1 lb. asparagus, tough ends trimmed safflower oil, for oiling pan

1 lb. firm tofu, crumbled

1/2 cup soy milk, rice milk, or other non-dairy milk of choice

2 Tbsp. arrowroot

2 Tbsp. nutritional yeast flakes

1 Tbsp. garlic, minced

1 1/2 t. agar-agar flakes

1 tsp. Dijon mustard

1 tsp. sea salt

1/4 tsp. turmeric

1/8 tsp. white pepper

1/4 cup freshly chopped basil

1/4 cup freshly chopped parsley

1/4 cup red pepper, fine diced

1/2 cup green onions, thinly sliced

1/2 cup vegan soy mozzarella cheese, shredded

Begin by preparing the asparagus: fill a medium saucepan half full with water, place it over high heat, and bring to a boil. Slice the asparagus spears diagonally into 1-inch pieces and place them in a fine mesh strainer. Place the strainer in the boiling water and cook the asparagus in the



water for 2 minutes to blanch them. Remove the strainer from the water and set the asparagus aside. Lightly oil a 10-inch quiche pan or spring-form pan and set aside. In a food processor, place the tofu, soy milk, arrowroot, nutritional yeast flakes, garlic, agar-agar, Dijon mustard, salt, turmeric, and

white pepper, and process for 2 minutes or until it forms a smooth puree. Pour half of the tofu mixture into the prepared quiche pan, evenly distribute the blanched asparagus and the remaining ingredients in the pan, and then top with the remaining tofu mixture. Using a spoon, slightly swirl the two mixtures together, and then smooth the top. Bake at 375 degrees for 35-45 minutes or until the filling is firm to the touch and dry on the top. Remove the frittata from the oven and allow to cool for 10 minutes before cutting. Serve warm, cold, or at room temperature. Garnish with sliced avocado. Yield: One 10-inch frittata.
