Finance Report from the Church Treasurer

Thank you for your continued support of the local Church budget. We have completed the first six months of our current budget year (Oct 1, 2013 to Sept 30, 2014). To review, our monthly budget goal is \$13,090/monthly. The offering for March 2014 was \$11,534.67 leaving a deficit of -\$6,940.28 for the six month period (not a good start as we head into the second half of the budget year). The total local budget offering shows a decrease of over 10% compared to the same time last year. The total tithe showed a decrease of 2.75% compared to last year.

Your strong support of the current building project has been a blessing. The parking lot has been repaired, we completed a successful and spiritual series of evangelistic meetings and the security wall is almost completed. To date over \$132,000 have been donated towards the project, this represents 80% of our goal of \$165,000. It is now time to continue our donations and build the **new restrooms**.

Funds are in hand to paint our church (\$11,881 have been donated for this needed project). Brent Hinger has vol-

unteered to paint the church along with other volunteers. Plans are underway to begin the painting project on May 15 this year.

Stewardship is the personal acknowledgement on our part that God is owner and provider of all the basic good of life - spiritual, physical, and material. As Christians, we are called to be faithful and responsible with the resources entrusted to us by God – our time, our talents, our assets, and the use of our spiritual gifts. As we start the second half of our budget year it is suggested that each of us do the following:

- Pray Consider what God has done for you and how He has filled your life with every good thing.
- Return Tithes You love God. Acknowledge and honor Him by returning the part He requests. Be mindful, however, that your tithe does not fund the Roseburg Church's ministry. Your entire tithe is sent to the conference office to fund ministry in Oregon and around the globe.
- Contribute Joyfully Offerings are voluntary.

They come from a heart overflowing with grace. The entire ministry of our local church is funded with offerings for our church budget. If you are currently contributing toward the Church Budget, thank you. But would you be so bold as to ask God how you could help your church even more? And if you haven't yet experienced the joy of supporting your church on a regular basis, there is no better time to start than now. God will bless you so amazingly.

Thank you for your continuing support of God's Church in Roseburg with your prayers and financial support.
