That this Child has defeated the foe.

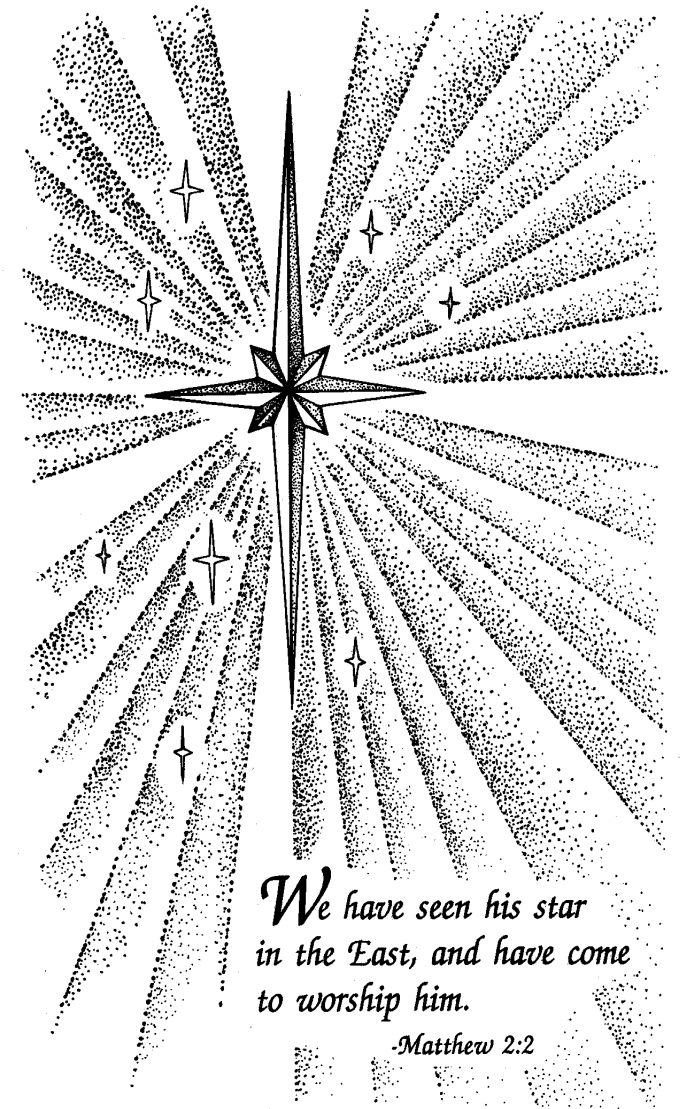
We muse on the innocent Baby so mild,
