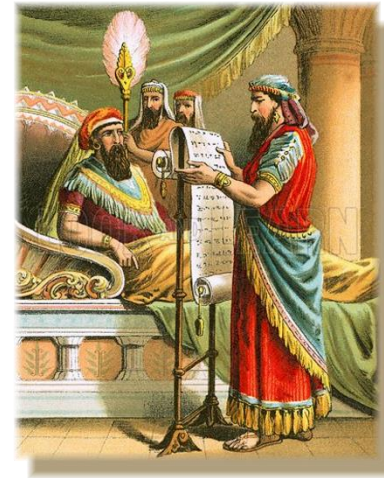
- April 17 - Young Adults Sabbath School - 10 a.m. Ages of 18-40 years old- class meets at the Youth Room.
